We have started off to another great semester here at the BSU. Let me give you a brief overview of everything we do *each week*. Every Monday, we have a Bible study on-campus. I lead this Bible study and we average around 20 students. On Tuesday mornings, we serve free coffee on campus and ask that anyone who takes a cup either write down a prayer request or talk to us about Christianity. Our goal with this event is to have gospel conversations, and most of time, it is our BSU students who do the talking. On Tuesday evening, we open up the gym at a local church and play sports and do worship together. We have our free lunch every Wednesday, and we average about 150 students right now. During the lunch we send our students out to tables to sit and share the gospel with their peers. I spend almost the entire time talking with students about various life and faith things. On Wednesday evening, we have our second Bible study of the week. This is an open discussion Bible where I give our student leaders the opportunity to do some teaching, and to practice creating conversations with others. I teach and give my input as well. We hit a record number of students at this study, having 33 on one night, which is huge for our BSU. We average 25-30 students at this Bible study. Every Thursday, Chloe and I open up our house for fellowship. Students come to our house at 1 pm and stay until 10-11 pm. We do this every Thursday, and we get around 10-15 students every Thursday that just come over to fellowship with us – they do their homework, play music, watch movies, play basketball, and also ask me their never-ending questions about the Bible and Theology. On Sunday, we take students to church. These are the things that we do every single week to accomplish our goals of the Great Commission, which includes evangelism and discipleship. We do plenty of stuff that isn't on our calendar. On Tuesdays I meet with students for one-on-one Bible studies, for example. I went out with our students to shovel sidewalks, and help someone move into their house. We are blessed that, even though we offer a BSU event every single day of the week, our students continue to show up to each one. We have plenty of students that come to every single event that I mentioned above. This is a huge blessing from our Lord, and the work He is accomplishing through this ministry is incredible.

We are continuing to raise funds for our Japan mission trip this summer. Right now we have 7 students signed up to go who are currently raising funds. \$1500 is due from each students in just a few weeks, and \$3500 will be due by May. We have been receiving donations from churches and individuals. We are humbled and deeply thankful for this, but the need is still great.

We are doing fundraisers over the next couple of months. On March 11th, if the weather permits, we will be doing a car wash and bake sale starting at 3:30 and going until it is dark. If you cannot support a student financially, one way you can support them is by baking something that we can sell at this event.
